#### **Purpose of Position:**

Macalester College, a NCAA Division III member of the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference is accepting applications for the position of Head Women's Soccer Coach. This position is full-time and reports to the Director of Athletics. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

#### **Qualifications:**

Minimum qualifications: Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution required; Master's degree preferred; coaching experience at the collegiate level required, head coaching experience preferred; demonstrated knowledge of NCAA and MIAC rules and a commitment to the academic development of student-athletes required. Demonstrated ability to work effectively with staff, faculty, students, parents, and alumni from diverse ethnic, cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds.

#### **Responsibilities:**

Responsibilities include the overall management of the program including coaching, the recruitment and retention of academically and athletically qualified student-athletes in a rigorous academic environment, scheduling and budget management, making travel arrangements, supervision of coaching staff, and occasional teaching duties as assigned.
